Dear Member,

We are pleased to share an update on significant improvements to our water system at Central Washington County Water Supply Corporation (CWCWSC). This project underscores our commitment to providing safe and high-quality drinking water to our community.

As a result of routine testing, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) issued an Agreed Order related to elevated levels of total trihalomethanes (TTHMs) in our water supply. TTHMs are disinfection byproducts that form when chlorine reacts with bromide and naturally occurring organic matter. Our water source is particularly rich in bromide, which can increase the formation of these byproducts.

In direct response to the order, we undertook a comprehensive project to address the issue. After a thorough evaluation of potential solutions, we installed 2 Kasco Marine Model 3400H/C61 submersible mixers. These units are specifically designed to improve water circulation within our storage tanks, which is highly effective in reducing the conditions that lead to TTHM formation.

We conducted a 3-month pilot project from August 1, 2024, to October 31, 2024. The mixers demonstrated significant success in reducing TTHM levels, ensuring compliance with safety standards. Based on these results, we proceeded with a full-scale installation. The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) reviewed and approved our project for permanent installation on January 22, 2025, and the project was promptly completed on February 3, 2025.

These mixers have been operating continuously for the last year. We are pleased to report that post-installation testing, conducted by both CWCWSC and TCEQ, has confirmed that our water now meets all state and federal regulatory standards. The Locational Running Annual Average (LRAA) for our sample points are well within the required limits of 80 parts per billion, successfully resolving the issues outlined in the Agreed Order.

We have officially certified to the TCEQ that all corrective actions have been completed, and our system is now in full compliance. We appreciate your trust and support as we continue to invest in our infrastructure to serve you better.
